



This was behind our home on █ College Street. The fire we saw, then the bomb exploded in the front seat of the van, under our 150 foot Cork Oak tree. My wife and I were in the yard we saw it and were able to put it out with a garden hose with our neighbors help after 25 minutes or more. If the batteries would have exploded it would have caused a toxic waste scene a thermal runaway combustion of batteries and set a fire that could not be put out for 48 hours with water or foam. This would have destroyed our home and the neighborhood, Left it a toxic mess and devalued, every home we feel this was the intent. To lay waste to our neighborhood, and then buy it at low cost for RL and RLM housing.

It was the day after five houses burned down on Lincoln Ave., we felt it was connected. Someone or a group of people tried to set fire to our neighborhood. That is true, it has to be solved so it doesn't happen again.

The Proposed new Zoning changes on our street are to be changed to RL and RLM we feel are linked to this arson attack July 11, 2023. It would have been easy to develop if we were all burned out, let us not be fools and see the connection here.

The policeman David Shepard and the Fireman came after it was out, twenty minutes or so later.

We felt the fireman should have listed it as arson because there was a device that exploded on the front seat? It was not handled as a crime scene and was towed back to Davis. The officer did confirm a bomb like device blew up on the front seat and that is what created the fireball I saw, it was arson for sure he said but seemed unconcerned.

When I asked the officer why it wasn't being treated as a crime scene he told me no crime was committed the only victim here was UC Davis and it was none of my business.

The way the fireman and the policeman treated us gave us no hope anyone would look into it, it made us ill and sick for weeks.

The State police in Davis are handling the case we were told by officer David Shepard.

When this happened the first thing we thought of was someone wants to develop this neighborhood and is trying to burn it down and no one cares but us but that is why we write this letter to you, it is your job to care, and we wish you to know what is happening.

It is small everyone knows everyone, but everyone is not involved in burning the down Woodland for their gain, so let us see the elephant in the room and stop it from trampling the whole town.

We ask you to investigate this case number 23-093426, it is a federal crime and the FBI needs to be involved., and the ATF. We want this Zoning plan on our street to not go through, A neighborhood of Mexican Americans, Elderly and young Contractors will not be bullied burned out or marginalized. We all have cameras now and light the alley, this has been very unsettling as you can imagine. We will not welcome any new development here my neighbors tell me. This is a neighborhood of family homes and will remain that.

We want this on the public record and to be considered on all changes on zoning on College.

The arson attack did happen with a bomb in our neighborhood, the day after five houses burned on Lincoln.. Any news media would realize there is a link that should be investigated and now with these new zoning changes on our street, our neighbors and we hope you, will now look at who you are doing business with if there is a connection, this is prudent and makes sense.

It is a very rich developer group we believe probably someone very well known with deep pockets investing with people in the city to burn down middle-class neighborhoods and destroy them so they can build their high density hell of RL and RLM housing. You probably know them very well but behind this cities back they are ruefully tearing it apart at the fabric.

Maybe that's how business is done today but not in Woodland we will fight back. Our neighborhood must not be to be bullied by developers that want to change a 115 year old neighborhood for their economic gain, and think they can burn it down and get away with it? Please don't look the other way or much will be lost with this behavior of this group.

This is the reason we are here informing you with the facts from our street, to know what happened and to seek action on this case.
