Note: Additional disposal fees for non-standard items (box springs, tires, televisions, etc) charged by Yolo County or City designated landfill will be charged to the customer when it is possible to identify the customer in violation.

- [1] Excess Yardage/Snapshot service fee would apply to Commercial Customers each time a Customer's Bin or Debris Box is overloaded. Driver documents the conditions with photographs, which are used by the Company in subsequent Customer contact.
- [2] The Trip Charge would apply when a Commercial Customer schedules a Debris Box service call that is not needed after Company arrives at the Customer location. Company must be given a 24 hour cancellation notice by the Customer.
- [3] The Inactivity service fee would be charged if a Customer has a Debris Box, temporary Bin, or Compactor longer than the 14-day rental period without scheduling a pickup. On the 15th day and going forward, the customer would be charged an additional \$15.31 per day. The maximum fee per month is \$229.85.
- [4] The Reactivation service fee would be charged for administrative costs to restart a Commercial Customer account that has been terminated pursuant to Section 7.1.2 of the Agreement due to non-payment.
- [5] The Delivery service fee would be charged for the delivery of a container to a Commercial Customer that is restarting services that were previously terminated pursuant to Section 7.1.2 of the Agreement due to non-payment.
- [6] The attached fuel Surcharge rate table will be applied to only the Debris Box line of business and will be calculated based on the cost of fuel on a monthly basis. This will be a line item on the customer's monthly bill.
- [7] The contamination fee is a pass-through contamination and/or administration fee imposed on by the landfill or disposal site for contaminated loads.
- [8] Company and the City shall meet and confer to negotiate a price.
