

RESOLUTION NO. 8540

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLAND
CERTIFYING THE 2025 REVISED SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, State General Waste Discharge Requirements (“WDRs”) were adopted statewide by the State Water Resources Control Board on May 2, 2006 and updated by Order No. 2006-0003, Order 2008-0002-EXEC, Order 2013-0058-EXEC; and Order WQ 2022–0103-DWQ; and

WHEREAS, the updated WDRs require each public agency that owns and/or operates a sanitary sewer system to meet specific requirements, including development and implementation of a system-specific Sewer System Management Plan (“SSMP”) and update/re-certify the SSMP every 6 years; and

WHEREAS, to comply with this requirement, the City Council certified the SSMP on June 16, 2009, re-certified the updated SSMP on June 13, 2015 and re-certified the new updated SSMP on December 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to re-certify the 2025 version of the SSMP.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Woodland as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby certifies the 2025 revised Sewer System Management Plan.

SECTION 2. A copy of the updated SSMP will be made available on the City of Woodland’s website.


