ORGANICS RECYCLING: YARD AND FOOD WASTE SERVICE

Woodland residents can recycle yard and food waste in one cart. Please place food scraps and yard trimmings in your organics cart (brown lid) to divert compostable items from the landfill. WM services organics carts weekly. Get a second organics cart at no extra charge. Call WM at (530) 662-8748 to order.



GREEN WASTE STREET PILE AND STREET SWEEPING

Street pile collection and street sweeping is provided by WM and offered weekly from November through January. At all other times, green waste street pile collection will only be offered once a month. Please do not place food waste in your green waste street piles. Visit EnviroWoodland.org/WasteWizard to view or download your collection calendar and even sign up for reminders about upcoming service days.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

HHW is any product labeled toxic, poisonous, corrosive, flammable, combustible or irritant. HHW items include paint, batteries, oil, pesticides, and other items. HHW is accepted every Friday and Saturday between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. at the Yolo County Landfill located at 44090 County Road 28H, Woodland.



Free HHW pickups available for senior (65+) and disabled Yolo County residents. Please visit yolocounty.org/landfill or call **530-666-8856** for more information.

BACKYARD COLLECTION

Carts can be collected from backyards and side yards for an additional fee or no fee for qualifying disabled individuals. Customers who qualify for this service must reapply annually. Call **(530) 662-8748** for details.



HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Waste Management does not operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. If the holiday falls on a weekday and your service day lands on or after a holiday in a given week, service will occur one day later, including Saturday for Friday collection.



ANNUAL BULKY DROP OFF EVENT

Waste Management offers residents a free drop off event once a year. Residents can dispose of bulky items such as furniture, appliances and electronic waste at no charge. This event typically takes place in the spring. Please visit WoodlandRecycles.com for more information.

COMPOSTING & RECYCLING NOW THE LAW

When food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard waste break down in a landfill, they produce methane, a potent greenhouse gas that contributes to climate change.

Effective January 2022, state law (SB 1383) requires all residents and businesses to recycle and keep compostable materials out of California's landfills by placing them in an organics cart for composting. Cart Set Out and General Information

- Wheel carts to curb by 5 a.m. on your collection day. Only Waste Management carts will be serviced. Other carts will not be emptied.
- Carts should be placed side-by-side at least 3 feet apart and 3 feet away from objects such as mailboxes, parked cars, and utility poles.
- Place carts at curb with handles facing away from the street.
- Do not overload carts. Lids must close. Overage fees may apply if cart is overflowing.
- Sort materials properly (tips inside). Unsorted materials in recycling or organics cart may be subject to contamination charges.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What if I'm unsure which cart my item goes into?

A: Look it up on the Waste Wizard by scanning this QR code or by going to EnviroWoodland.org/WasteWizard. Search for items not listed here to find out which cart it goes into or how to properly dispose of it.



Q. Should I set out my carts if they're not full?

A. Yes. Your carts should be set out weekly, even if they are not full, to avoid odors, vectors, and overfilling the following week.

Q. Do I need to rinse out my recyclables prior to placing them in my recycling cart?

A. No. However, liquids and food cannot be placed in the recycling cart. Food and liquids spoil the recyclability of paper and cardboard. If necessary, scrape or wipe to remove food from containers.

Q. Can I bag my food waste before putting it in the organics cart?

A. Yes, but only in BPI Certified compostable bags. Plastic trash bags or grocery bags are not accepted in the organics cart.

Q. What will happen if I use my recycling and organics carts as a trash cart?

A. Trash can ruin an entire load of recyclables and organics. If you place trash in your recycling or organics carts, you may be billed for additional trash collection and penalties may apply.

Q. What do I do if I miss my pickup?

A. Call customer service at (530) 662-8748 to schedule a special pickup for an additional charge. Or wait until your next service day.

Q. What happens if a cart is stolen or damaged?

A. Contact customer service at (530) 662-8748 to replace or repair your cart.

Q. How do I clean my cart?

A. Simply rinse, drain excess water into grass or other landscaping, and allow to dry. Do not rinse excess water down the storm drain. Place food waste in compostable bags or containers, such as a cardboard box. Cart cleaning services are available from WM for a fee.
