Background

Woodland adopted district boundaries in 2016 using 2010 Census total population counts. All cities with district-based election systems, like Woodland, must redistrict after each Census. This process is called redistricting. This keeps population counts within each district relatively equal to ensure equal representation. The City Council desires to establish an Advisory Redistricting Commission to assist in reevaluating districts using the new census data.

Role of the Advisory Redistricting Commission

The Advisory Redistricting Commission will facilitate the process of adjusting Council district boundaries for elections between 2022 and 2030 and hold public hearings to gather public input. The Commission will submit 1 to 5 draft map proposals to Council based on community input and Council will select one preferred map. Commissioners should be open-minded, impartial, and community-minded. The Council's goal is that the Advisory Redistricting Commission will represent the geographic, ethnic, and social diversity of the City. Learn more at cityofwoodland.org/redistricting.
