

WOODLAND'S UPDATED TREE ORDINANCE

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT TREES AT YOUR HOME

Proposed removal or major maintenance of trees (trimming branches 3+ inches in diameter, cabling, or other similar acts) at your home will require the submittal of a **Tree Modification Review Form** if you have the following types of trees:


- 1) Heritage Oaks (valley oaks 33-inches in diameter or greater at breast height) located anywhere on a single family residential parcel
- 2) Any type of tree 24-inches in diameter or greater at breast height located within 20-feet back of walk (20-feet measured from the back of the sidewalk)

This process **must be completed** before any work on these trees is performed.

* Diameter at breast height is measured 54-inches above ground level
