Tree Permits shall be issued once the following conditions are met:

- 1) The owner has established, to the satisfaction of the Director of Community Services, or designee, that there is a need for the proposed work on the street tree but that the City is unable to do the work within the timeframe desired by the owner; and
2) The owner has established, to the satisfaction of the Director of Community Services, or designee, that the persons who are to perform the work are qualified to do so (contractors that have an ISA-certified arborist on staff); and
3) If removal is requested, such removal has been approved by the Urban Forest Subcommittee after a recommendation by the City's Community Services Director, or designee.
4) Major Maintenance performed on the tree may only be performed after the issuance of a tree permit approved by the Community Services Director, or designee.
5) If removal is approved, a notice of such removal must be posted on the tree a minimum of 48-hours in advance of said removal.
6) All work conducted on public street trees within the City of Woodland must be performed by a business that has an ISA-certified arborist on staff and a valid City of Woodland business license.
