

# Traffic Calming 101

This is a basic guide to the City of Woodland's evaluation & implementation process for traffic calming

## CHECK

Search to see if your address is in an area where traffic calming may be permitted at [bit.ly/woodlandtrafficcalming](https://bit.ly/woodlandtrafficcalming) or the QR code >



## REQUEST

A Woodlander contacts Traffic Engineering with an area of desired traffic calming (see contact info below)

## ELIGIBILITY

City staff determines if the requested area is eligible for traffic calming

## STUDY

If eligible, staff begins a warrant study with three possible outcomes:

- Warrants not met, no traffic calming approved
- Warrants met for passive traffic calming (e.g. striping and speed limit signs)
- Warrants met for active traffic calming (e.g. speed bumps and medians)

Areas are prioritized for funding by study score, which correspond to those areas most severely in need of traffic calming

## IMPLEMENTATION

Areas eligible and prioritized for funding then go through this process:

- Plan preparation
- Internal City staff plan review
- Neighborhood review and approval
- Public notice of project
- Implementation of project
- Post-implementation study
